

CAMPING RULES

Dear guests,

Thank you very much for choosing our campsite, we'd like to take this opportunity to welcome you and wish you a pleasant stay!

To maintain everyone's enjoyment and pleasure we kindly ask you to abide by the following campsite rules:

BY ENTERING THE CAMPSITE, YOU ACKNOWLEDGE AND CONFIRM TO ABIDE BY AND RESPECT THE HOUSE RULES.

The violation of House rules may result in the cancellation of the accommodation service and eviction from the campsite.

- Every guest must register at the reception upon arrival. Unregistered stay in the camp is prohibited.
- Every guest must report all items used according to the camping pricelist. Unregistered items used will be considered as they've been present since the first day of camping and charged accordingly.
- The campsite can be entered between 07:00 and 23:00.
- Check-in is from 07:00-21:00.
- Check-out and cashier opening hours are 08:00 to 20:00, and a break is from 12:30-13:30.
We recommend settling the bill one day before the departure.
- All received passes and keys must be returned to the reception upon departure.
- Any damage to the campsite's property will be charged accordingly.

During the stay, it is mandatory to:

- Immediately report any infectious disease to the campsite management.
- Wash dishes and clothes only in designated places.
- Park your car only in designated places and on your own pitches.
- Register the marine vessel at the campsite reception.
- Park vessel trailers in the designated parking lot marked on the campsite map. Trailers left outside of the Designated trailer parking lot will be removed.
- Connect to the electrical network only in designated places and report it to the reception staff.
- Use only gas and electric barbecues!
- Respect the quiet hours from 23:00 to 7:00. Vehicles are not allowed to enter the campsite from 23:00 to 07:00 and driving motor vehicles inside the campsite and creating unnecessary noise is prohibited.
- Sort through your waste and dispose of it properly in designated places.
- Take care of your belongings. The management of the campsite is not responsible for any lost or damaged property belonging to the guests nor for accidents or injuries caused by the negligence of guests inside the campsite.

It is prohibited:

- to LIGHT A FIRE IN THE CAMPSITE!
- for children to enter the toilet facilities unaccompanied by adults.
- to use irons, hot plates and other appliances without constant supervision.
- to put up fences around campers/caravans or tents, and to destroy the campsite's property.
- to operate any type of motor vessel at a distance of less than 300 m from the shore.
- to drive vehicles around the campsite at a speed greater than 20 km/h. Drive electric scooters with extreme caution around pedestrians and other vehicles.
- to demolish any movable and immovable property of the campsite. The campsite management reserves the right to charge for damaged property and to permanently prohibit the perpetrators from entering the campsite.
- to damage vegetation. Our plants grow patiently to enhance your camping experience. DO NOT tear branches off the trees and pick flowers.
- to park the vehicle outside the marked lines.

Pets:

- Pets must be registered at the reception desk at check-in and a valid travel document must be presented for each pet.
- In the campsite area pets must be kept on a leash.
- Pets are allowed in mobile homes and bungalows and subject to a special pet charge different from the ones applicable to campsite pitches.
- Please note that not all guests have pets. Do not allow pets to climb on the bed and sofa.
- In case of any damage, the owner will be liable for damages.
- Pets are allowed on the pitches and a special pet charge applies, different from the one applicable to mobile homes/bungalows.
- Pets are not allowed on campsite beaches, except those intended for pets. Be considerate of others and do not walk your dog on beaches not allowing pets. The pet-friendly beaches are marked on the map of the campsite.
- Please always pick up after your pet.

Marine vessels:

- Piers at the campsite is not intended for longer stays, only for picking up or dropping off passengers.
- Reservations are not possible, but guests may announce that they will have a vessel (boat, speedboat, inflatable boat, Jet ski, etc.) when making a reservation.
- Guests are obliged to report a marine vessel when checking in at the reception desk. Charges will apply as indicated in the price list on the Antony-boy campsite.
- The boat slip is located about 2 km from the campsite in the village at address: 13, 20250, Viganj, Croatia. If the assistance is needed, guests must announce it at check-in and arrange a date and a time that's convenient.

Beach rules:

Our beaches are equipped with free sun chairs and showers. To maintain everyone's enjoyment and pleasure we would ask you to observe the following beach rules:

- Please mind that each part of the beach has its designated activity and use.
- PRACTICING WATER SPORTS AND ACTIVITIES IS PERMITTED, EXCEPT WITHIN OUR DESIGNATED SWIMMING ZONES.
- DURING HIGH WINDS IT'S ADVISABLE FOR SWIMMERS AND KIDS TO STICK TO THE DESIGNATED SWIMMING ZONE BECAUSE OF INCREASED TRAFFIC IN THE CHANNEL AND FOR YOUR OWN SAFETY.
- WATER SPORTS OR SPORT ACTIVITIES CONDUCTED ON WATERBODIES MUST ABIDE BY THE RIGHT OF WAY RULE SET AND GIVE RIGHT OF WAY TO ALL OTHER VASSELS (boat, speedboat, sailboat Jet ski, etc.)
- TAKE CARE OF YOUR SPORTS GEAR AND NEVER LEAVE IT UNNATENDED. THE MANAGEMENT OF THE CAMPSITE IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY LOST OR DAMAGED PROPERTY BELONGING TO THE GUESTS NOR FOR ACCIDENTS OR INJURIES CAUSED BY THE NEGLIGENCE OF GUESTS INSIDE THE CAMPSITE, ON THE BEACH OR THE SEA.
- Sun chairs cannot be reserved.
- Sun chairs must not be removed from the beach nor taken into the sea.
- Be considerate of others - do not occupy a larger number of sun chairs than you actually need.
- You may only use the sun chairs while you are at the beach.
- When leaving the beach, you must take with you all the things you have placed on. The sun chairs otherwise they will be removed by the campsite staff and/or a campsite guest if no other sun chairs are available.
- Be considerate, a towel does not need a sun chair if you leave it by itself.
- Compliance with these rules prevents conflicts and tension between guests. Violation of public order and peace is punishable by law.
